The Chamber of Commerce for Greater Moncton has been reaccredited by national accreditation council

The Chamber of Commerce for Greater Moncton has passed the reaccreditation process from the Chamber Accreditation Council of Canada (CACC). The CCGM has been accredited for a period of three years from 2019 to 2021.

The accreditation from CACC is a formal acknowledgement that member chambers of commerce, or boards of trade, have been successfully evaluated against rigorous national standards of policy, service, and performance.

Chamber CEO John Wishart said the accreditation shows the organization is operating at a superior level in both governance and operational aspects.

"Our organization is part of a group of elite chambers of commerce in Canada", Wishart said. "This seal of excellence testifies that the Chamber is run in a strategic and professional way and has reached the standard in Chamber excellence."

Chambers that received the accreditation must actively engaged in three core activities: policy and advocacy, membership programs and services, and organization/governance. They also need to have business processes and practices in place that have met with national accreditation.
