The legalization of recreational cannabis in Canada is imminent and the Chamber of Commerce for Greater Moncton (CCGM) wants to give all the tools to the business community of the region to approach this historic change.

The CCGM, as part of its Deloitte Distinguished Speaker Series, will present a luncheon event called **Cannabis in the workplace – What business needs to know** on October 11<sup>th</sup>, 2018 at the Hotel Crowne Plaza Moncton. Lucie Laboissonnière from McInnes Cooper and Tina Shannon from Organigram will offer their perspective on this important matter.
